AND REGULATION

No. 1.—Milliners' working hours, from A.
M. to P. M.; Friday and Saturday evenings, to
P. M., on account of orders. One hour is allowed for Dinner and Tea.

No. 2.—The work will be given out by the Head Milliner, and her orders must be strictly complied with.

No. 3.—Milliners wishing to be absent, must get permission of the Head Milliner; in case of sickness, they will send notice, if possible, to the Store.

No. 4.—Any time lost, for whatever cause, will be deducted from the wages.

No. 5.—Milliners will be paid off regularly every Saturday Evening by the Head Milliner.

No. 6.—No Milliner will leave her work unless

the Goods are sent out in the Store, and her place is in good order.

No. 7.—The Apprentice will bring and carry out all the Goods for Milliners. She has to keep the Room clean and in the best of order.

No. 8.—Milliners wishing to purchase Goods for themselves, can do so by applying only to Mr. Zinsser.

No. 9.—Visitors are not allowed in the Work Room.

No. 10.—The Head Milliner will see that the above Rules are strictly complied with; any disobedience of the same she will report to one of the Firm.

Repeated disobedience of any of these Rules will be considered sufficient cause of discharge.
