REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE.

We are now able to inform our subscribers that, after fully supplying the requirements of the Hospital, and providing a staff of twenty Nurses for the districts into which Liverpool is divided, we have now about fifteen women available as Nurses for private families. As it will probably be unnecessary to add largely to either of the two former classes, the greater proportion of the Nurses annually trained will now be available for private Nursing, and we hope that the present number will be rapidly increased. To attain this result we have been obliged to act with what, in a pecuniary aspect, may seem rashness. We give our Nurses a thorough training at a cost for which, as yet, the public have not provided sufficient means. This we have ventured to do in the belief that, by rendering our work as perfect as possible, and thus making more evident the advantages which not only private families, but also the poor, for whom our system provides, would derive from its operation, we should deserve and receive the confidence and support of the people of Liverpool. We think that we may now fairly claim for our native town that it has been the first to organise Nursing, for rich and poor, on a business-like and systematic principle, and to set an example which has been already and will be yet more widely followed elsewhere.

Having such results to show, we believe that we shall not ask in vain for the means which are absolutely necessary to enable us to carry on efficiently the work we have begun.
