But their special desire and aim is to set forth a complete and perfect representation of the condition of women in every country at the present day and particularly of the women who are wage earners, whether their work be mental or manual; to portray the legal, political and industrial status of women.

In many States and Territories, the members of the Woman's National Board are officially recognized as members of the State Boards, having thus received both National and State recognition, an adjustment of authority which greatly facilitates their work. Such has been the case in the State of Rhode Island.

In order to expedite the gathering and arrangement of exhibits and statistics in this State an Advisory Board of women was formed and by their aid and co-operation it has been possible to tabulate the employments of women as herein set down.

The advantages which must accrue to woman from this display of her efforts are so many and so obvious that it seems unnecessary to point them out. It will show that there is scarcely an occupation in which man is engaged, in which women cannot also work; it will show in what industries and arts she is best fitted to excel; it will show what the world owes to woman for the moral influences which have shaped the destinies of men and nations; it will develop many facts not hitherto recorded; it will open new and wider avenues of employment and secure more liberal recognition and increased facilities in those which woman already occupies; it will attract attention to her capabilities and her needs in such a way as must inure to her permanent benefit.

For the purpose of preserving in concrete shape the facts so laboriously accumulated by the members of the Rhode Island Women's Advisory Board, it has been thought best to present this mass of statistics in the form of a Directory. This work, accomplished in a field not before trodden, is now submitted to the public.
