





Banned in Burbank

"It's an incredible combination of horrors," said James Richmond, urging his colleagues on the Burbank City Council to cancel a series of concerts by Patti Smith, Jackson Browne, Todd Rundgren, Blue Oyster Cult, and Roxy Music. "One of the groups that was talked about tonight, the police department has suggested, would draw mostly a homosexual crowd. I really don't think that's what we want in town."

The council concurred and the concerts were dropped. Patti Smith had the following response: "This is a dangerous precedent and contrary to the very essence of the country. . . . As I do not judge the children of the councilmen and the citizens of Burbank, let them not judge mine."
