Presentation copy from Fanny Burney to her youngest sister, Sarah, inscribed by her on the reverse of the

half-title of volume I: "For my dear sister Sarah from the Author".

Sarah, youngest daughter of Charles Burney, was herself a considerable novelist, her most successful work being Charlentine. The important 21-pp. dedication to Doctor Burney, is significantly marked, presumably by Sarah, with special reference to the passages on novel-writing.

The sheets appear to be proof-sheets, and probably represent one of the earliest copies of the book to come

into the author's hands. Examples of the survival of proofs of this date are extremely rare.
